## About Rock Foundation UK

We are a **front-line charitable organisation**, founded in 2009 by our CEO Pam Hodge. Rock was created to provide **new and unique provision** for young people and adults with **learning disabilities** and those who are **disadvantaged**.



Through a wide variety of practical workshops and supported work placements we aim to help our service users develop independence, life and employment skills. Service users increase their self-esteem and ultimately improve their quality of life.

### **Workshops & Activities**

We have a range of departments and creative workshops that our service users access and participate in:

Admin, Animal Care, Charity Shops, Crafts, First Aid, Gardening, Hair Dressing, IT, Radio Station, Sewing, Tea Rooms, Training Kitchen, Woodwork and much more.



Being part of the Rock Family is not just about training and work, but also includes a lot of fun and relaxing activities. As well as workshop sessions there is plenty of time for fun together, with indoor and outdoor activities, day trips and other outings.

#### **Staff Team**

The Rock Foundation employs approximately forty staff whom are all trained in the key aspects of care delivery and have experience of supporting vulnerable people. One on one support is also available where this is highlighted in the individual's care plan.

As a team we aim to help our service users develop life and employment skills, to increase their self-esteem and independence, and ultimately improve their quality of life.

Our staff also benefit from an ongoing training programme and undergo regular supervision and appraisals. Full details of the training undertaken by our staff can be obtained from our management team.









#### **Our Caistor Site**

At the Caistor site we have safe and secure accommodation, providing supported living for up to 12 residents with learning disabilities, as well as day care services that additional students attend.

Service users are supported and encouraged to participate in a range of activities, including serving in the tea rooms and gift shops along with a range of other social enterprise projects, both indoors and outdoors.

## **Social Enterprise Projects**

We have developed a variety of social enterprise projects and have retail sites as well as an Etsy Online Gift Shop, which provide training and volunteering opportunities to our clients, as well as being a means of revenue for our charitable work.





#### **Rock Food Bank Hub**

Our food bank provision was developed in 2014, in response to urgent local need, which currently averages 300 service users per day including some referrals from different agencies. Our Food Bank is based at our site on Garibaldi Street in Grimsby and is open: Mon, Wed and Fri from 1pm to 3.30pm.

Our vision for this project is to be able to offer a benefits advice and sign-posting service to other local agencies in the near future.
